

How to change hosting account main password

Every hosting account does have a main password that allows you to access your hosting account via SSH and FTP or to access cPanel directly.

So If you wish to access your account via SSH or cPanel directly you must know the main password.

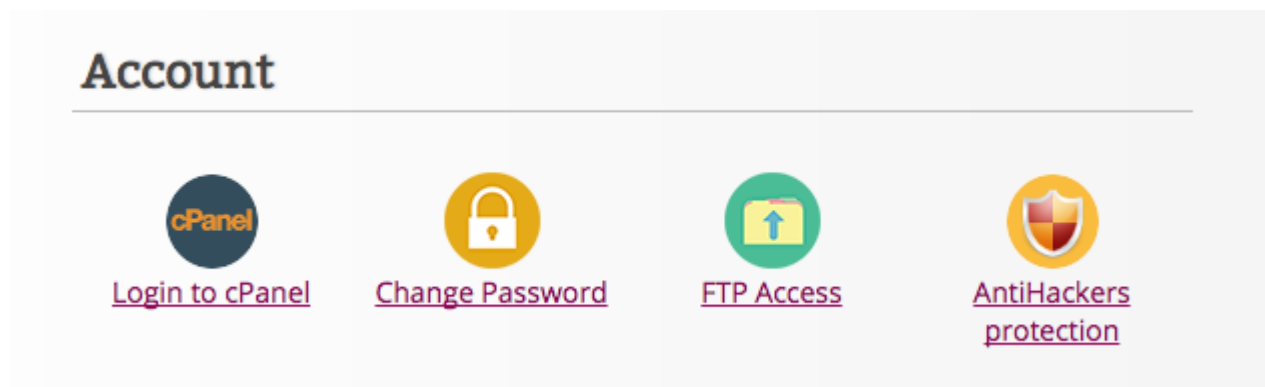
In order to define the main password of your hosting account follow these steps:

Just follow instructions of How to access your Hosting Panel.


2 - Click on Change Password
